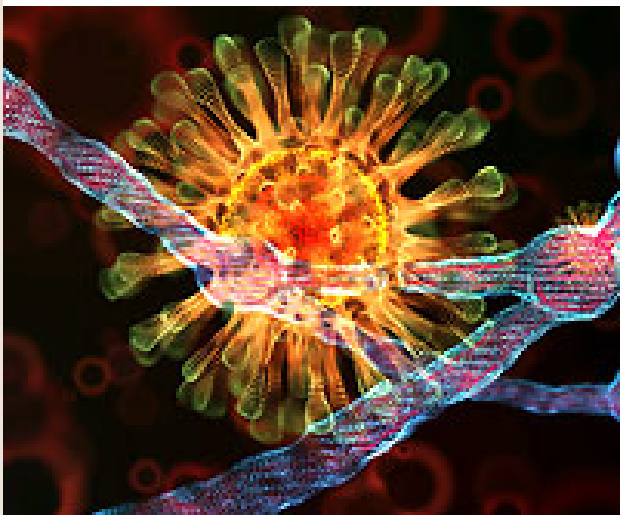


Young Racer Uses Determination & Charm to Get Back on the Track

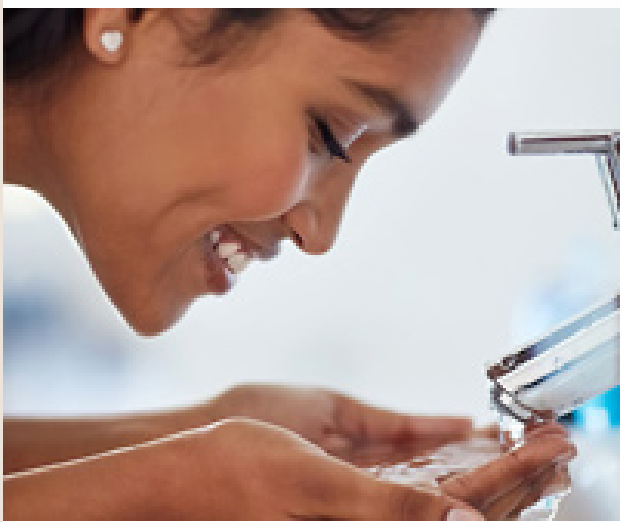
