Opportunities for support at the Samaritan Foundations

ArtsCare - Enhancing the healing environment through the presence of art and music in health care settings, positively impacting the physical and emotional well-being of patients, visitors and staff.

Equipment - Ensures residents can receive care in their own communities.

Greatest Need/General Unrestricted - Unrestricted funds can be used where the greatest need is determined by foundation boards.

Hospice - A philosophy of care for people of all ages in the last stages of terminal illness.

Reach Out and Read - Pediatricians start each visit by giving children a new book to take home, discussing with caregivers the benefits of reading, and modeling positive reading interactions with their children.

Patient Support Program - Provides funding assistance for patients in need to promote equal access to care and facilitate safe hospital discharge with assistance for expenses such as medical bills, transportation, prescriptions, nutritional supplements and groceries through the program.

Samaritan Treatment and Recovery Services – Residential and intensive outpatient treatment programs for adults (ages 18+).

•Mid-Willamette Valley - Programs provide support funds for staff, program and patient assistance for treatment and recovery services provided for substance use illnesses, as well as the continued renovation, repair and improvement of the Samaritan Treatment and Recovery Services facility in Lebanon. (Program fund resides at Lebanon Community Hospital Foundation)

•Central Coast - Capital funds are used to establish a 16-bed Samaritan Treatment and Recovery Services facility in Lincoln County (Newport). Program funds enhance on-going care by providing equipment, education, programs and services in the Samaritan Treatment and Recovery Services center on the coast, including group and individual therapy, medication-assisted treatment and peer-delivered services. (The coastal program fund resides at Pacific Communities Health District Foundation, Newport).
